The operational period of the Coordination Office is expected to be from early 2027 until at least the end of 2035.

- consortia of multipleinstitutions or organisations in oneormore countries.

Bids must be from institutions/
organisations in countries that have an
existing active Arcticand/orAntarctic
research programme. Please see the
memberships of the International Arctic
Science Committee (IASC) and the
Scientific Committee on Antarctic Research
(SCAR) for examples of countries with
active Arctic and/or Antarctic research
programmes. Institutions/organisations
from countries not members of either IASC
or SCAR may also apply if they can show
an existing active Arctic and/or Antarctic
research program or are providing a joint
bid with a country that does.
